- 5. Application must be received by May 12, 2017. Send completed application to:**

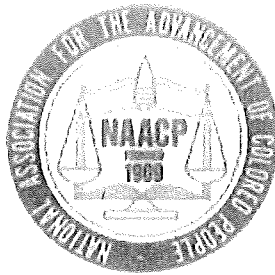
