- 3. <u>Silly Swim Wear</u> Contestants will show off their creative side by showcasing their favorite swimwear. The more ridiculous and silly the better. *Swim suit ideas/looks will need to be school appropriate. (Examples: scuba gear, swim floaties, rubber duck floats, etc.)
- <u>Talent Competition</u> Contestants will have 1-3 minutes to showcase their talent. We are looking for unique, fun and weird performances. *Must be school appropriate and all technical needs will need to be communicated to Mrs. Mutter no later than March 10th.
- 5. <u>Question & Answer Competition</u> Dress in a suit/formal wear, each contestant will be asked a question at random and judged for the effectiveness of their answer, the confidence in their delivery and overall presentation.
- 6. After a short intermission, the winner is selected. - 3. All contestants agree to be present at the rehearsal and performance of the event.
- 4. All contestants agree to meet with the choreographer to learn the group dance on the days available.
- 5. All contestants must turn in their talent declaration by March 10th.
- 6. Failure to follow these rules will result in disqualification. If this happens during the performance removal from the building and further disciplinary actions will occur.
